NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

- A. The financial statements of Superior Dental Care, Inc are presented on the basis of accounting practices prescribed or permitted by the Ohio Department of Insurance.
- The Ohio Department of Insurance recognizes only statutory accounting practices prescribed or permitted by the state for determining the financial condition and results of an insurance company, for determining its solvency under the Ohio Insurance Law. The National Association of Insurance Commissioners' (NAIC) Accounting Practices and Procedures manual has been adopted as a component of prescribed or permitted practices by the State of Ohio.
- The preparation of financial statements in conformity with Statutory Accounting Principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities. It also requires disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenue and expenses during the period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.
- Dental premiums are earned ratably over the terms of the related insurance contracts. Expenses incurred in connection with acquiring new business, including sales commissions, are charged to operations as incurred.
- In addition, the company uses the following accounting policies:
