1. Fair Value Measurements by Level 1, 2 and 3

The Company must determine the appropriate level in the fair value hierarchy for each applicable measurement. The level in the fair value hierarchy within which a fair value measurement in its entirety falls is determined based on the lowest level input that is significant to the fair value measurement in its entirety. The Company's management is responsible for the valuation process and uses data from outside sources (including nationally recognized pricing services and broker/dealers) in establishing fair value.

Level 1 inputs are quoted prices (unadjusted) in active markets for identical securities that the reporting entity has the ability to access at the measurement date.

Level 2 inputs are inputs other than quoted prices within Level 1 that are observable for the security, either directly or indirectly. Level 2 inputs include quoted prices for similar securities in active markets, quoted prices for identical or similar securities that are not active and observable inputs other than quoted prices, such as interest rate and yield curves.

Level 3 inputs are unobservable inputs for the asset or liability.

The Company did not hold any investments measured at fair value at June 30, 2016 or at December 31, 2015.

The Company uses the end of the reporting period as its policy for determining transfers into and out of each level. There were no transfers between Level 1 and Level 2 during the three and six months ended June 30, 2016 and 2015, respectively.

2. Roll forward of Level 3 Items

The Company did not hold any Level 3 securities carried at fair value during the three and six months ended June 30, 2016 or 2015.

3. Policy on Determining when Transfers between Levels are Recognized

At the end of each reporting period, the Company evaluates whether or not any event has occurred or circumstances have changed that would cause an instrument to be transferred between levels. The Company's policy is to recognize transfers in and transfers out as of the end of the reporting period.

4. Inputs and Techniques Used for Level 2 and Level 3 Fair Values

The Company is responsible for the valuation process and uses data from outside sources (including nationally recognized pricing services and broker/dealers) in establishing fair value. Pricing services use a variety of observable inputs to estimate the fair value of fixed maturities that do not trade on a daily basis. These inputs include, but are not limited to, recent reported trades, benchmark yields, issuer spreads, bids or offers, reference data and measures of volatility. Included in the pricing of mortgage-backed securities are estimates of the rate of future prepayments and defaults of principal over the remaining life of the underlying collateral. Inputs from brokers and independent financial institutions include, but are not limited

to, yields or spreads of comparable investments which have recent trading activity, credit quality, duration, credit enhancements, collateral value and estimated cash flows based on inputs including delinquency rates, estimated defaults and losses, and estimates of the rate of future prepayments. Valuation techniques utilized by pricing services and prices obtained from external sources are reviewed by the Company's internal and affiliated investment professionals who are familiar with the securities being priced and the markets in which they trade to ensure the fair value determination is representative of an exit price. To validate the appropriateness of the prices obtained, the Company's internal investment professionals, who report to the Chief Investment Officer, compare the valuation received to independent third party pricing sources and consider widely published indices (as benchmarks), recent trades, changes in interest rates, general economic conditions and the credit quality of the specific issuers. If the Company believes that significant discrepancies exist, the Company will perform additional procedures, which may include specific inquiry of the pricing source, to resolve the discrepancies.

Level 1 consists of publicly traded equity securities and highly liquid, direct obligations of the U.S. Government whose fair value is based on quoted prices that are readily and regularly available in an active market. Level 2 primarily consists of financial instruments whose fair value is based on quoted prices in markets that are not active and include U.S. government agency securities, fixed maturity investments and perpetual preferred stocks that are not actively traded. The Company primarily uses the market approach valuation technique for all investments.

Subsequent events have been considered through August 10, 2016, the date of issuance of these financial statements. On July 25, 2016, the Company's ultimate parent, National Interstate Corporation (the "Corporation"), announced that it had reached an agreement with American Financial Group ("AFG"), pursuant to which Great American, a wholly-owned subsidiary of AFG, will acquire all of the outstanding common shares of the Corporation (the "Common Shares") that are not currently owned by Great American, pursuant to the terms of the merger agreement (the "Merger Agreement"), by and among the Corporation, Great American, and GAIC Alloy, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Great American ("Merger Sub"). Great American is currently the owner of approximately 51.0% of the outstanding Common Shares of the Corporation.

The Merger Agreement provides for the merger of Merger Sub with and into the Corporation, with the Corporation surviving the merger as a subsidiary of Great American ("the Merger"). Pursuant to the transactions contemplated by the Merger Agreement, shareholders of the Corporation will receive \$32.00 in cash for each Common Share that they hold. In addition, the Merger Agreement provides that the Corporation will pay a special dividend of \$0.50 per Common Share upon the closing of the merger.

The Merger is expected to close in the fourth quarter of 2016, subject to approval by shareholders of the Corporation, including approval by a majority of shareholders other than Great American, and regulatory authorities, as well as the satisfaction or waiver of customary closing conditions.

For purposes of computing the recorded case and IBNR estimates, management of the Company analyzes historic data and estimates the impact of various loss development factors, such as our historic loss experience and that of the industry, trends in claims frequency and severity, our mix of business, our claims processing procedures, legislative enactments, judicial decisions, legal developments in imposition of damages and changes and trends in general economic conditions, including the effects of inflation. Additionally, management utilizes analysis that is derived from a review of quarterly results performed by actuaries employed by Great American Insurance Company.
