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NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**Note 1 – Summary of Significant Accounting Policies and Going Concern****A. Accounting Practices**

The financial statements of Transport Insurance Company ("the Company") are presented on the basis of accounting practices prescribed or permitted by the Ohio Department of Insurance.

The Ohio Department of Insurance recognizes only statutory accounting practices prescribed or permitted by the state of Ohio for determining and reporting the financial condition and results of operations of an insurance company, for purposes of determining its solvency under the Ohio Insurance Law. The National Association of Insurance Commissioners' ("NAIC") Accounting Practices and Procedures Manual has been adopted as a component of prescribed or permitted practices by the state of Ohio.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**D. Going Concern**

In our most recent analysis done in May 2021, the cash and invested asset balance, excluding restricted balances pledged as statutory deposits, along with the remaining balance on the NICO cover (on a paid basis) were compared with the claims payments patterns plus a \$3m annual load for overhead. That analysis showed that the Company has the ability to continue as a going concern beyond one year from the financial statement issuance date. After that analysis was prepared, the Company lost a reinsurance arbitration which challenged those cash flow assumptions. Transport's parent infused capital of \$1.8m in June to cover the Company's overhead thereby rendering the impact of the lost arbitration neutral to the cash flow analysis done in May.
